Foundation Stone of the “Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah Memorial Pakistan - Maldives Community Centre” Laid at Mulakatholu Atoll with Pakistan’s Assistance.

On Sunday, February 14, 2022 a ceremony held at Muli, Mukhatholhu Atoll, where H.E. Vice Admiral (R) Ather Mukhtar, High Commissioner of Pakistan and President of M. Atoll Council Mohamed Nimal laid foundation stone of the ‘Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah Memorial Pakistan - Maldives Community Centre’ at Muli with Pakistan’s Assistance. Mr. Zulqurnain Ahmad, Deputy Head of Mission, also accompanied the High Commissioner. The ceremony was attended by the Hon’ble Members of Parliament of Mulak Constituency Ibrahim Naseer and Dhiggaru Constituency Ikraam Hassan. Pakistani High Commissioner also presented a cheque of MVR 2,621,400/- (Two million six hundred- twenty one thousand four hundred) to the President of M. Atoll Mohamed Nimal. Today, the foundation stone has made another monument of friendship between people of Pakistan and Maldives”. He noted that Pakistan has been working with government of the Maldives in the areas of education, health, sports, human resource, social sectors and capacity building. High Commissioner assured that Pakistan High Commission will always be ready to assist the brotherly people of Maldives. The High Commissioner also thanked the people of M. Atoll for the warm welcome and hospitality.

President of M. Atoll Council, Mohamed Nimal while paying gratitude for the generous gift from the people of Pakistan to the people of Maldives, highlighted the need for the Community Centre. He underscored that the Community Centre would serve as a premises of temporary stay for those who seek medical treatment at M. Muli; It would be a place to hold community gatherings; it would help in Human Resource and Capacity Building including many others community activities. He said the construction of the Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah Memorial Pakistan - Maldives Community Centre’ will be completed on priority and in timely manner, so that it would be available for used by the people of the Atoll.
